The project may concern different fields of endeavours: an artwork exhibition, a panel discussion, a stage play with a school class, a meditation, a benefit concert, a conference etc. The concept and conduct of the same as well as duration is up to the initiator.

Reconciliation as a state of mind

Reconciliation starts by reaching out to those who are near, by creating sound mutual relationships as a basis of a worldwide network for peace and order, equality and justice for all mankind.

The mental state of reconciliation enhances farsightedness and emotional stability as a basis for cultural integration and linkage, and as synthesis in overcoming antagonisms and conflicts.
